Project Title : Construction of Ashuganj 400 MW Combined Cycle Power Plant (East)

- 1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from Asian Development Bank (ADB) and also applied for a financing/ loan from Islamic Development Bank (IDB) towards the cost of Power System Efficiency Improvement Project and it is intended that a Part of this loan will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to eligible bidder(s) from eligible source countries of ADB and IDB as defined in the Bidding Documents (Section 5).
- 2. Ashuganj Power Station Company Ltd. (APSCL), ("the Employer"), an enterprise of Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB), invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Demolition, Disposal of existing plant, site preparation and Detailed Engineering, Design, Manufacture/Procurement, Inspection, Testing, Delivery to site, Installation, Construction of related civil works, Commissioning and Performance test on turnkey basis of Ashuganj 400 (±5%) MW Combined Cycle Power Plant (East) including two years defect liability period. The Plant capacity shall be in the range of 400 (±5%) MW net at site ambient conditions of 35°C, 1.013 bar atmospheric, 98% relative humidity. The configuration of the plant shall be 1: 1: 1 (Single shaft without Bypass Stack). Fuel shall be natural gas supplied from Bakhrabad Gas Distribution Company Limited (BGDCL) and generated power will be evacuated to 400 KV national grid through new 400 KV GIS Sub-Station.
- 3. International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's and IDB's "Two Stage" Bidding Procedure.
- 4. To be qualified for bidding against this IFB:
 - The prospective Bidder shall have essential experiences in the supply, construction, testing & commissioning of at least one Combined Cycle Power Plant having minimum capacity of 300 MW within the last 10 years. The plant shall have been in satisfactory operations for at least three (3) years at the date of bid submission.
 - (Note: Only important qualification criteria are mentioned above briefly. To know the other qualification criteria, intending bidders are advised to inspect the Bidding Document by visiting the website of APSCL for view only but not for submission.)

The method of payment will be either in Pay Order or Demand Draft in favor of the Ashuganj Power Station Company Ltd., Ashuganj, Brahmanbaria, Bangladesh.
- 7. 1st Stage Bid must be delivered to the Project Director, Ashuganj 400 MW CCPP (East), Ashuganj Power Station Company Ltd., Ashuganj, Brahmanbaria-3402, Bangladesh on or before 12:00 noon Bangladesh Standard Time on 20-07-2016. Bidders are requested to submit sealed envelope. The First Stage Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline in the presence of bidder's representatives who choose to attend.
- APSCL will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by bidders on connection with the preparation or delivery of bids, site visits, etc.
